Advanced Life Support Millage Proposition 2022

Shall the constitutional limitation on the amount of taxes which may be imposed on all taxable real and personal property, in the Charter Township of Springfield, Oakland County, Michigan be increased by a new additional millage of 0.75 mill (\$0.75 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of ten (10) years, from 2022 through 2031, inclusive, to provide funding for the operation and maintenance of Advanced Life Support services within the Township, including personnel ambulances, and equipment? It is estimated that 0.75 mill will raise approximately \$575,000 when first levied in 2022. Yes
